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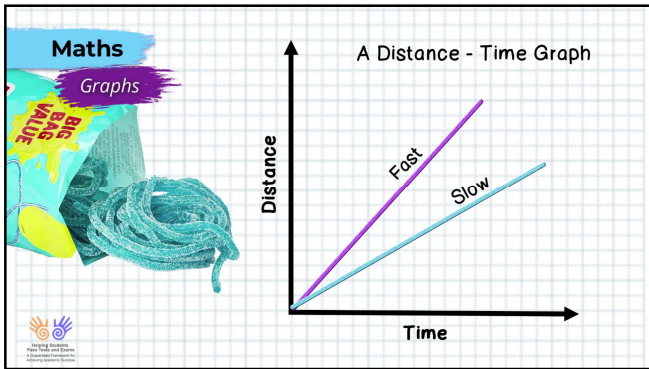

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### Drama and Theatre

Rehearsal essay extract

In class, we explored Stanislavski's technique of emotion memory, where an actor draws on past feelings or memories to stimulate an emotional response. In this scene, Maggie is angry at how Mae and Cooper's children have messed up her beautiful lace dress. Her frustration is shown through the hyperbolic language of slobbering and drooling to show her annoyance towards the children and how pathetic and immature she finds them. In the rehearsal process, the actor could recall a time when they remember feeling irritable. Evoking these memories and how the actor felt at the time will help the actor create a more realistic piece of theatre as the audience will see that. For example, at the start of Maggie's monologue, she says: 'Hear them? Hear them screaming?!'. The actor would deliver this in a loud volume, as they are trying to shout over the children, and also with an upturned tone, with emphasis on the word 'screaming' to show Brick how infuriated they make her feel.

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
